City tax on recreational marijuana retailers' sale of marijuana items

Shall Roseburg impose a three percent tax on sales of marijuana items by recreational marijuana retailers in the City?

If adopted by the voters, this measure would impose a three percent tax on sales of marijuana items (including marijuana, marijuana products and marijuana extracts) by recreational marijuana retailers licensed by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission and located within the City of Roseburg. The tax would be collected from consumers by recreational marijuana retailers at the point of sale. Recreational marijuana retailers would remit the three percent tax to the City. The three percent City tax would be imposed in addition to any state taxes on the sale of marijuana items. The three percent City tax would not be imposed on medical marijuana sales.

Explanatory Statement

Approval of this measure would impose a three percent tax on the sale of recreational marijuana items by recreational marijuana retailers within the City of Roseburg. The tax would be collected at the point of sale and remitted by the retailers. There are no restrictions on how the City may use the revenues generated by this tax.

Under Measure 91, adopted by the Oregon voters in November 2014, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission must license the retail sale of recreational marijuana. The Oregon Legislature subsequently provided that a city council may adopt an ordinance imposing up to a three percent tax on the sale of recreational marijuana items (which include marijuana concentrates, extracts, edibles, and other products intended for human consumption and use) by licensed recreational marijuana retailers in the City, but the City Council must refer that ordinance to the City's voters at a statewide general election. The Roseburg City Council adopted an ordinance imposing a three percent tax on the sale of recreational marijuana items by licensed recreational marijuana retailers in the City and, as a result, has referred this measure to the voters.

If approved, this three percent City tax would be imposed in addition to any state marijuana taxes. This three percent City tax would not be imposed on medical marijuana sales.
