AUTHORITY TO ENTER UPON PROPERTY

2.28.010 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to provide the authority for the county to perform activities that are necessary to evaluate real property which the county is considering for acquisition by purchase, condemnation, or otherwise. It is declared that the powers set forth in this chapter shall be regarded as essential governmental functions of county concern. (Ord. 82-10-5 §1, 1982)

2.28.020 Establishment. In any instance whenever state statute or county ordinance authorizes the county to appropriate private real property for public use, the county shall have the power and authority to enter upon, examine, survey and select such property for the proposed public use. Examination of the property may include engineering studies, environmental studies, and other studies necessary for proceeding with the proposed public use. (Ord. 82-10-5 §2, 1982)
