12.04.010 Definitions. For the purposes of this chapter, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings set out as follows:

- A. "Board" means the Douglas County board of county commissioners.
- B. "County governing body" means the Douglas County board of county commissioners.
- C. "Circuit Court" means the Circuit Court for the State of Oregon for the Sixteenth Judicial District, located in the county. (Ord. 80-7-1 §1, 1980)

12.04.020 Short title. This chapter shall be known as the "county ways of necessity ordinance." (Ord. 80-7-1 §2, 1980)

12.04.030 Purpose. This chapter shall remove the county governing body from jurisdiction over the establishment of ways of necessity and establish jurisdiction within the Circuit Court. (Ord. 80-7-1 §3, 1980)

12.04.040 Statutory authority. This chapter is adopted in accordance with ORS 376.200, which gives the board authority to adopt such an ordinance. (Ord. 80-7-1 §4, 1980)

12.04.050 Jurisdiction. The Circuit Court is granted the jurisdiction for establishment of ways of necessity and shall follow the procedures for establishment of a way of necessity provided under ORS 376.150 to 376.200. (Ord. 80-7-1 §5, 1980)

12.04.060 Appeal. An appeal from the decision of the Circuit Court for the State of Oregon for the establishment of the ways of necessity shall be to the Court of Appeals for the State of Oregon. (Ord. 80-7-1 §6, 1980)
