

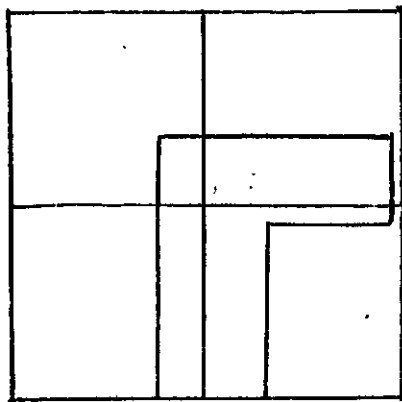

 South 40.00 chns. post is a bl. oak 4" dia. from which
 a bl. oak 36" in dia. bears $N 50^{\circ} W 87$ lks. dist.
 From bl. oak 10", being the $SE BT$ of NE corner of sect 7.
 East 4.40 and North 1.04 chns. set post, from which
 a dbl. alder 48" in dia. bears South 4 lks
 $N 89^{\circ}50' E 19.94$ set post, from which
 a fir 48" in dia. bears $N 57^{\circ} E 13$ lks. dist.
 South 40.00 chns. set post from which

 (at 37.42 " " 13.75 North of $\frac{1}{4}$ post)
 Set post with a brick for SW corner, from which
 a wh. oak 30" in dia. bears $N 86\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 3.18$ chns
 " bl. " 30" " " " $S 43\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 2.71$ "
