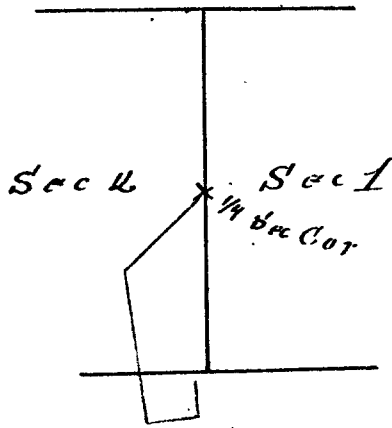


No ~~180~~ <sup>20</sup> Survey for A. J. Chapman (T 26-6)



From a point on the line between Sections 1 & 2  
 T 26 S R 6 W 4.50 chains south of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec Cor  
 between said sections 1 & 2 with mag. Va.  $19^{\circ}-30' E$   
 $S 42^{\circ}-15' W$  21.58 chains from which a  
 W. Oak 14' dia bears  $S 74^{\circ}-15' E$  1.08 chains dist  
 Thence  $S 20^{\circ}-00' E$  42.87 chains to a white  
 oak tree 14' dia faced on 4 sides  
 Thence  $N 66^{\circ}-30' E$  15.00 chains from which a  
 W Oak 12' dia bears  $N 80^{\circ}-00' W$  176 links distant  
 Thence  $N 9^{\circ}-30' W$  7.50 chains to the center of  
 the County Road running East & West  
 Surveyed April 30<sup>th</sup> 1887
