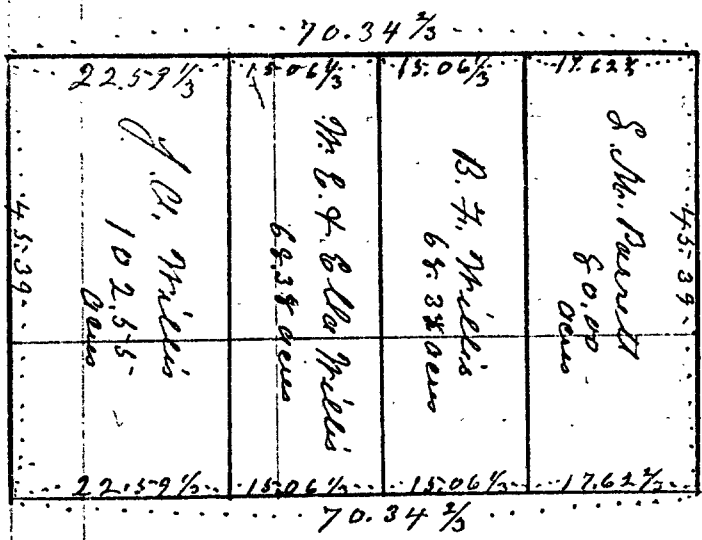


Wm A Willis Estate

Survey made March 24th 1893 to divide up the above plotted Donation Claim of Wm A. Willis and Wife El Me 45. Beginning at the S. E. Corner of the claim as found by the original Field Notes Thence North on East boundary of claim find the distance to be 45.39 chains. Thence West on North boundary of claim found the distance to be 70.34 2/3 chains. The West and South boundaries being the same making the content by my measurement 319.31 acres and at a former date there being 80 acres sold off the East end of claim leaving a remainder to be divided between the heirs of 239.31 acres. Thence from the N. E. corner I measured West 17.62 2/3 chains set a cedar post 4 feet long 4 ins square 24 ins in the ground marked C. S. for the N. W. corner of the 80.00 acre tract now belonging to S. M. Parrett Thence West 15.06 1/3 ch set cedar post 4 feet long 4 ins square 24 ins in the ground marked C. S. for the N. W. corner of an 68.38 acer tract for B. F. Willis it being also the N. W. cor of W. E. & Ella Willis; Thence West 15.06 1/3 ch set cedar post 4 feet long 4 ins square 24 ins in the ground. Marked C.
